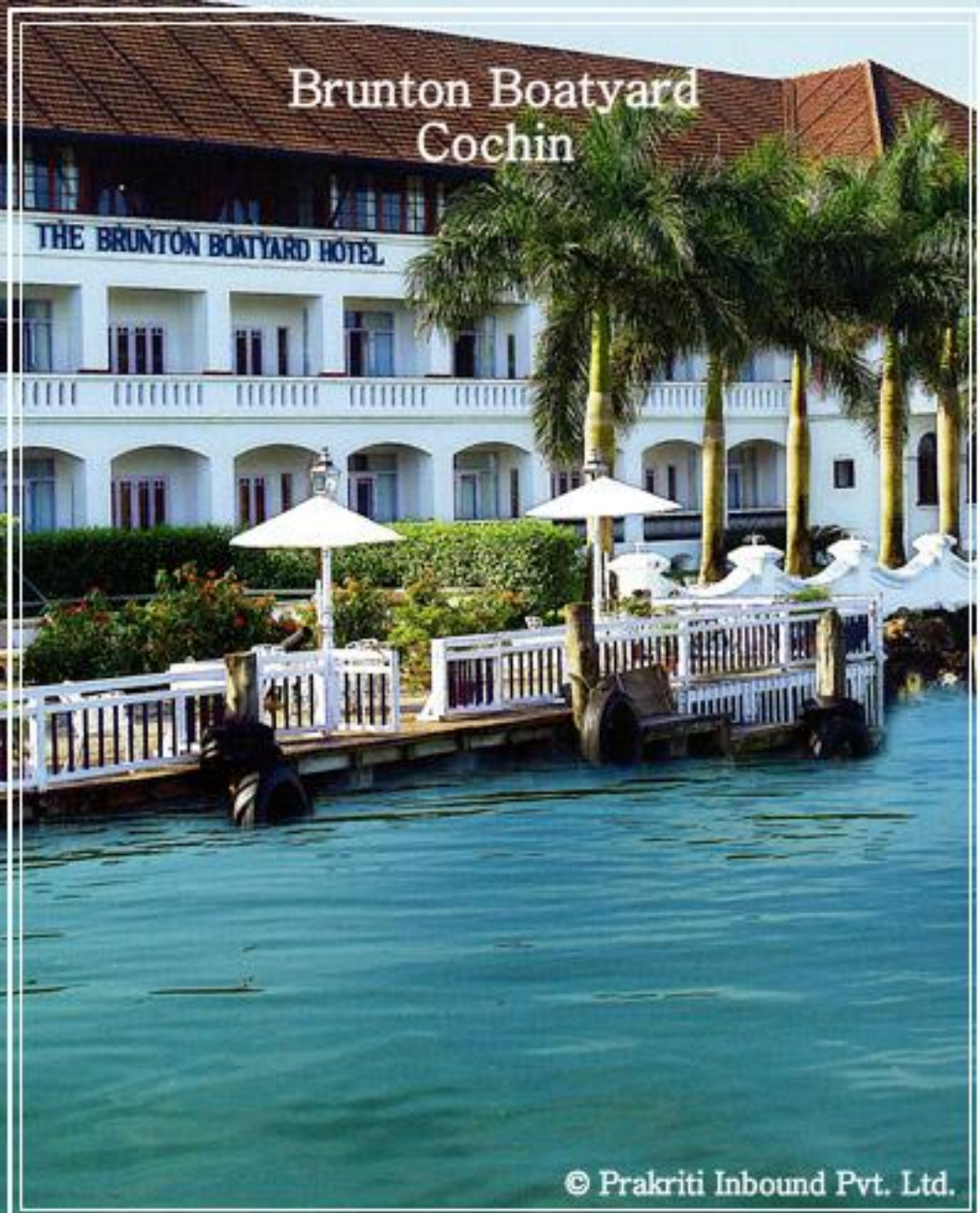

Day 1: Arrive Kochi

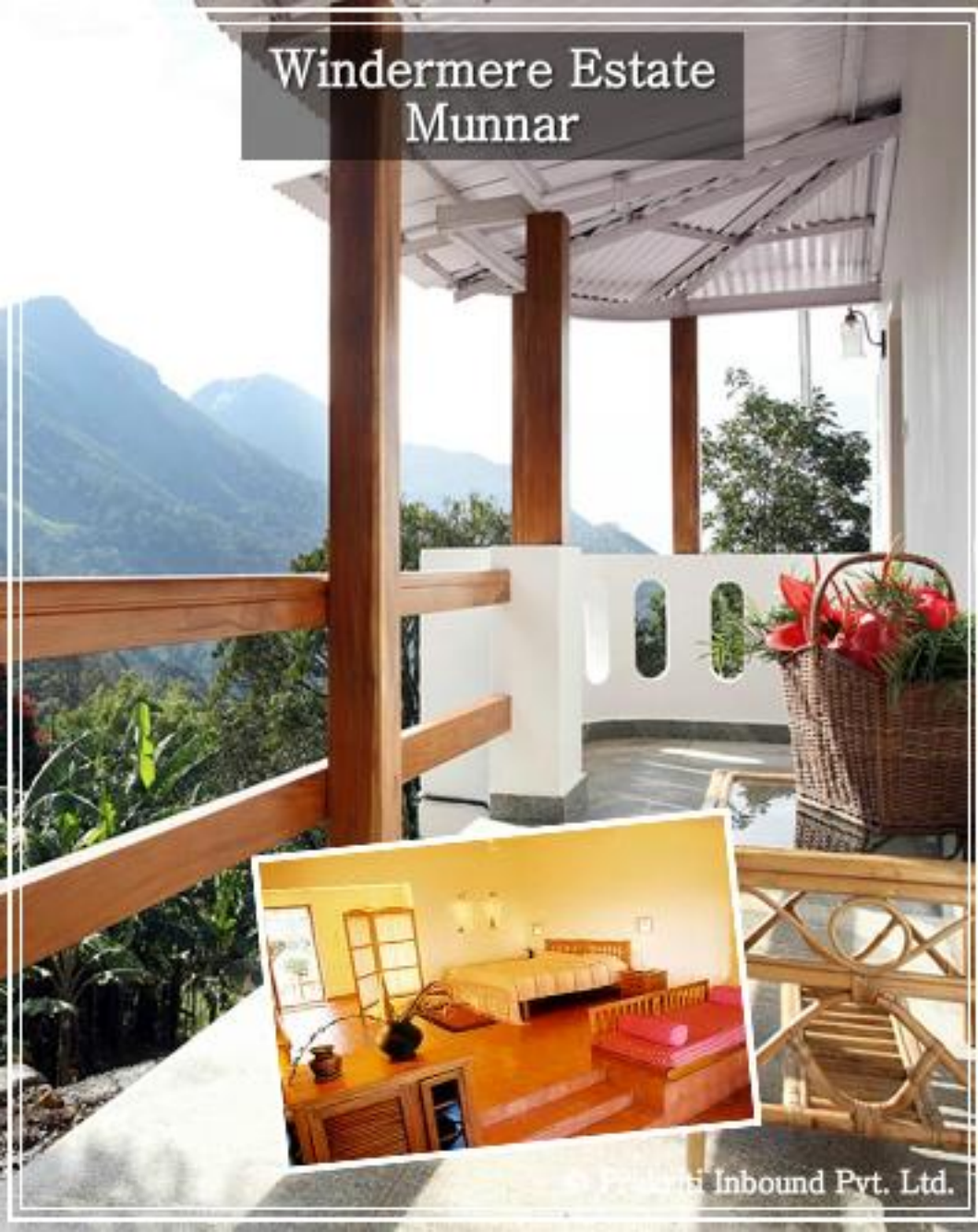

Day 2: Kochi - Munnar

Proceed for a half-day tour of Cochin. Visit Fort Cochin walk to the church of St Francis, the oldest European-built church in the country. Continue with a visit to Mattancherry, where you will visit the historic synagogue in the Jewish Quarter. You will also visit the Mattancherry or Dutch Palace, with its fine collection of mural paintings depicting scenes from the Hindu epics. Thereafter, drive past the amazing Chinese Fishing Nets. Also drive past Willingdon Island. Later, drive to Munnar (128 km / 3.5 hr. approx.). Arrive Munnar and check in to your hotel and relax. Overnight in Munnar.

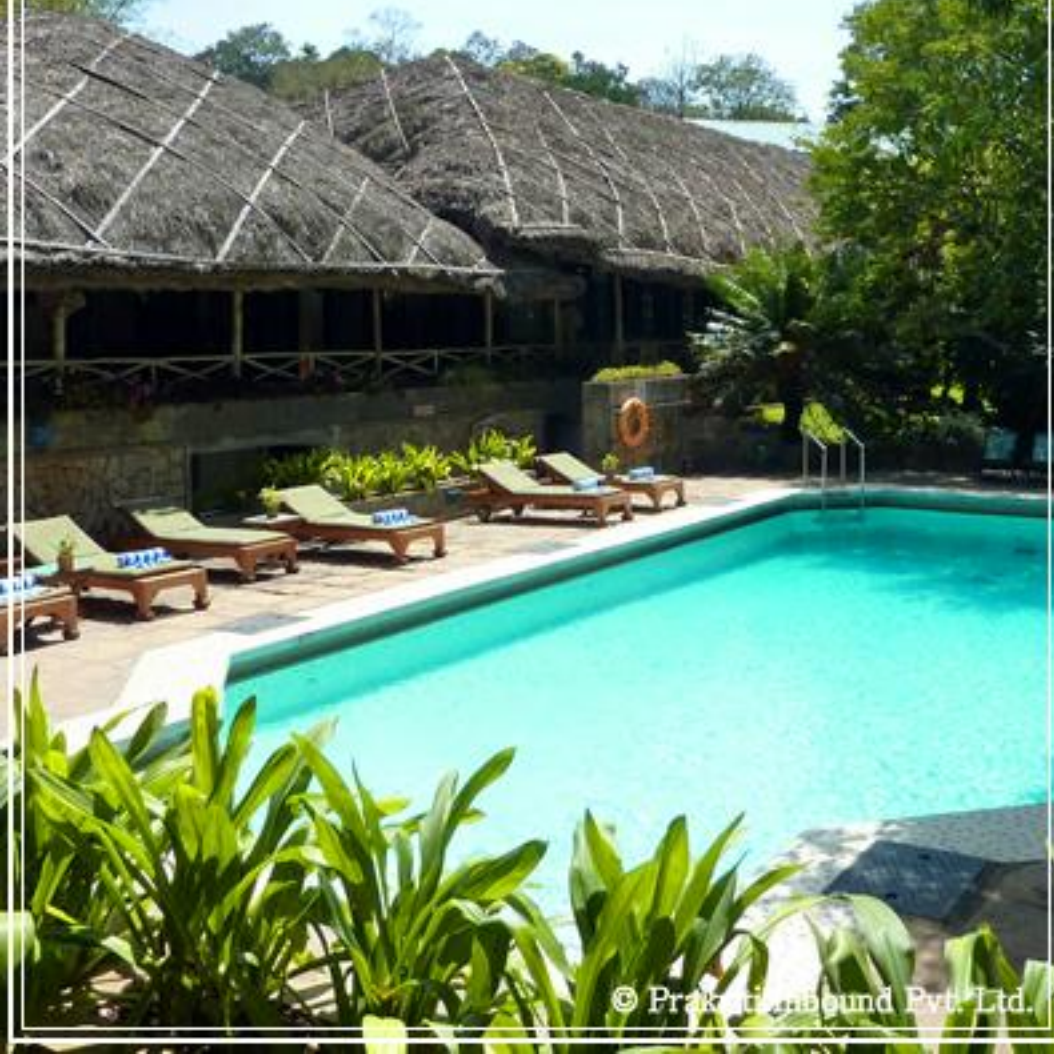
Day 3: Munnar

Proceed for a full day tour of Munnar. Visit the Tea Museum, which showcases some of the interesting aspects of tea plantations in Munnar. Also visit Mattupetty, known for its dam and the beautiful lake. Later visit the Kundala tea plantations and the Kundala Lake the mountain slopes here are thick with undulating, evergreen tea plantations. Here you can view the entire process of making tea, right from plucking of tealeaves to their processing. Overnight in Munnar.

Day 4: Munnar - Thekkady

Drive to Thekkady (90 km / 2 hr. approx.). Arrive Thekkady and check in to your hotel. Proceed for a full-day tour of Thekkady. Visit Periyar wildlife sanctuary, where herds of wild elephants have made Periyar Lake their favorite haunt for frolicking in the water. Later, take a spice plantation tour. Spices found in here include pepper, clove, cardamom, nutmeg, ginger, turmeric, vanilla and curry leaves. Enjoy an elephant ride in Periyar. Overnight in Thekkady.

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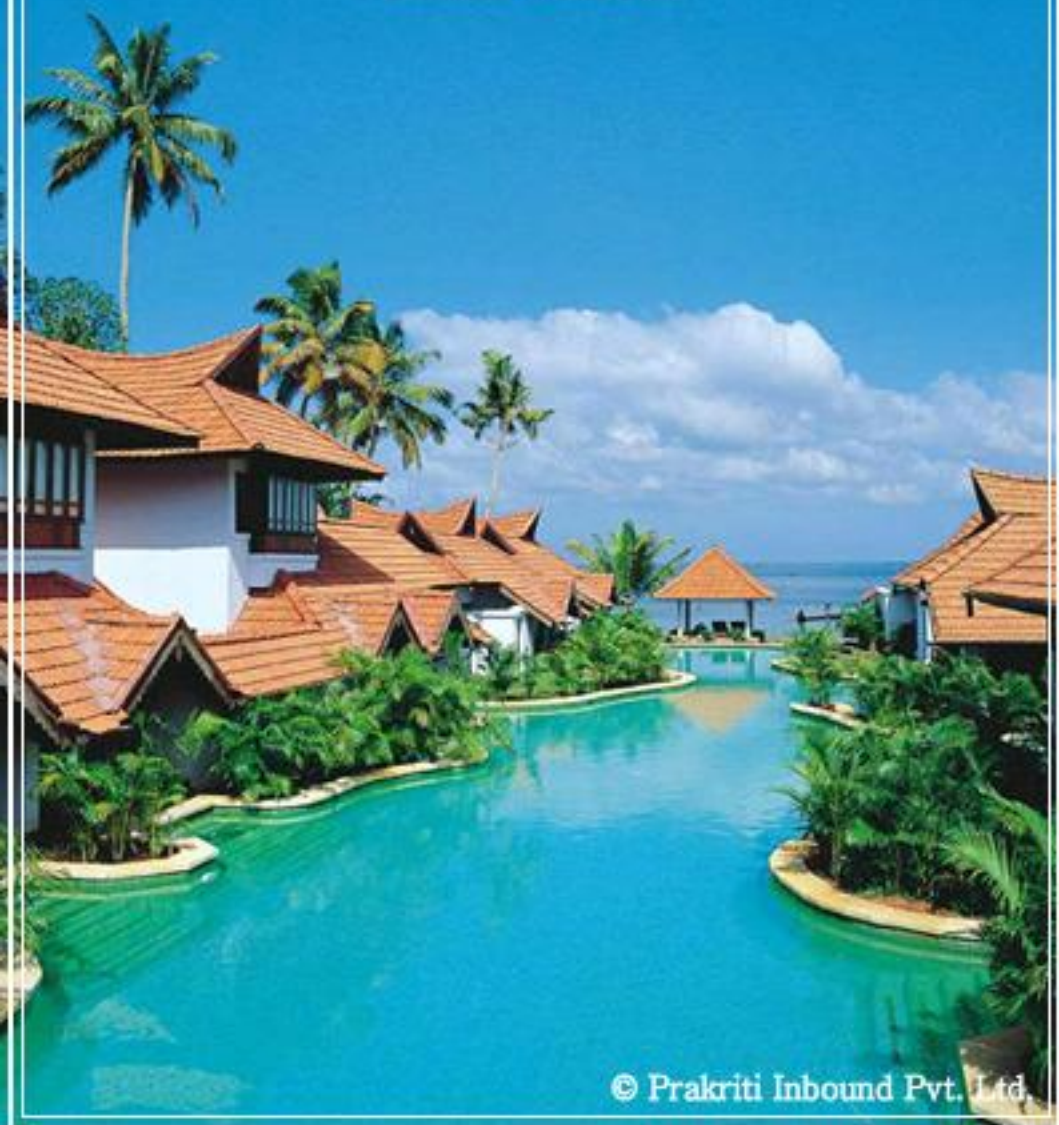
Day 5: Thekkady - Kumarakom

Drive to Kumarakom (120 km / 3 hr. approx.). Arrive Kumarakom and check in to your hotel and relax. Kumarakom is Kerala's Venice of the East a heartland of lagoons and mangrove fields, inter-linked with hundreds of narrow winding canals. Overnight in Kumarakom.

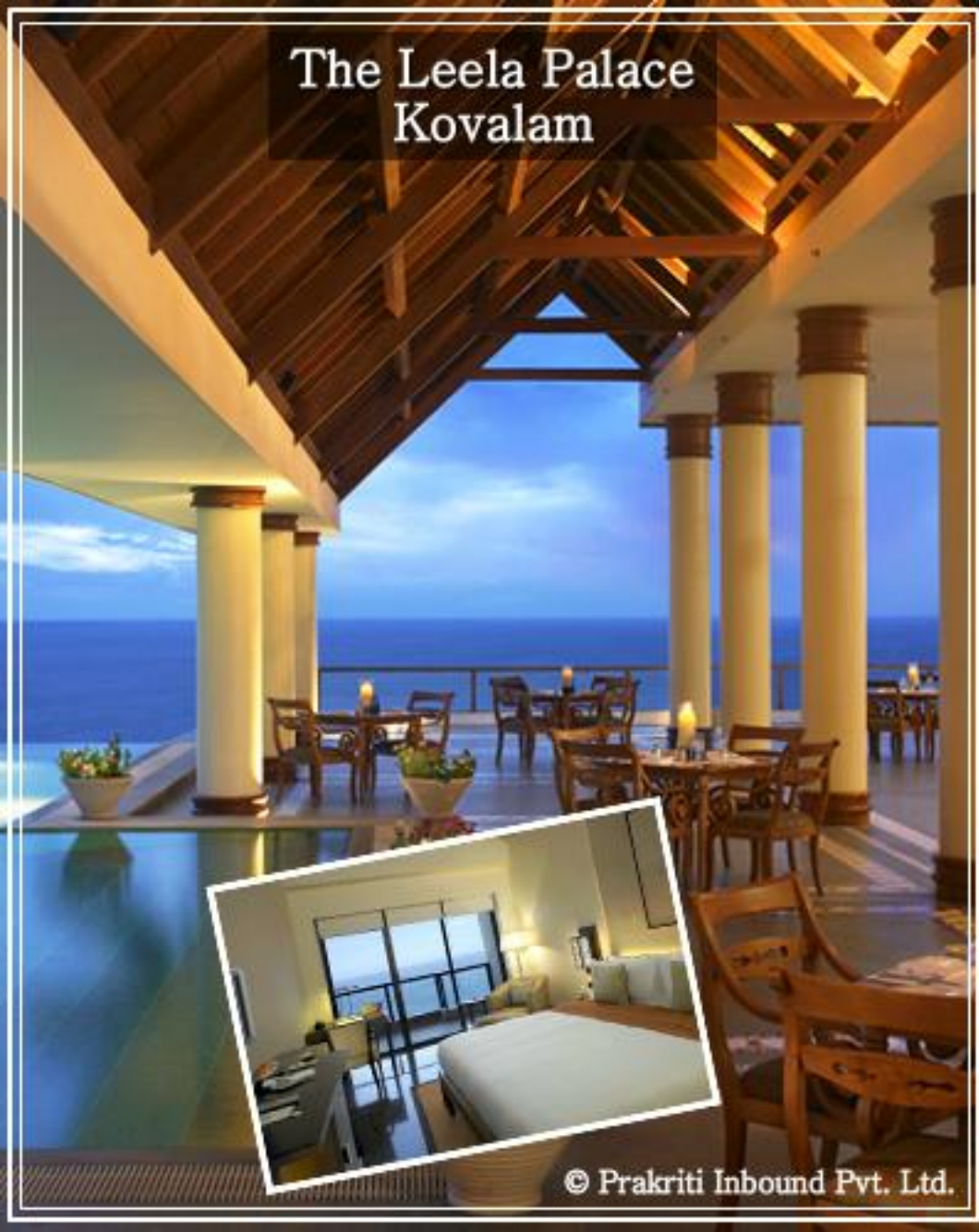
Day 7: Kumarakom – Alappuzha

Day 9: Kovalam

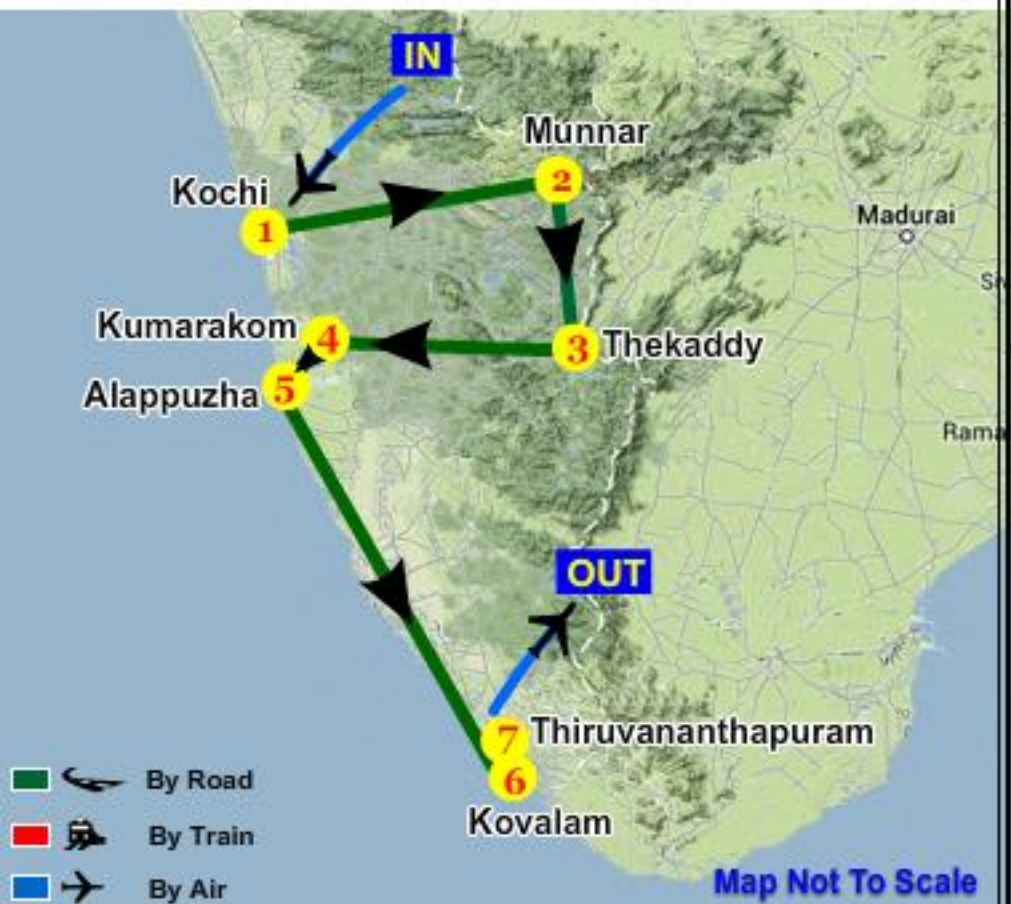

End your tour with the Veli Tourist Village a beautiful picnic spot where the Veli Lake merges with the Arabian Sea. Overnight in Kovalam.

Drive to Trivandrum airport (11 km/ 30 min approx.) to board the flight for your onward destination.

General guidelines while Traveling to Indian subcontinent

Visa Formalities /Information

- Foreign nationals wishing to travel to India are required to possess a valid passport of their country and a valid Indian visa. However, nationals of Nepal and Bhutan do not require visa to enter India and nationals of Maldives do not require visa for entry in India for a period up to 90 days (a separate visa regime exists for diplomatic/official passport holders).
- The Consular Passport and Visa (CPV) Division of the Ministry of External Affairs is responsible for issuing Indian visas to foreign nationals for their visit for various purposes. This facility is granted through various Indian missions abroad.
- Visa fees are non-refundable and subject to change without notice. The Embassy / High Commission/Consulate reserves the right on granting and deciding the type/duration of visa irrespective of the fees tendered at the time of making the application.
- Visa on arrival facility is limited to the below listed nationalities.
-Only for citizens of Finland , Luxembourg, Singapore, New Zealand, Japan, Cambodia, Laos, Vietnam, Philippines, Indonesia and Myanmar.
