

#### Introduction

Land of Maharajas leads you through some of the exciting cities of Rajasthan, as well as unlocking a few hidden gems which lie slightly off the well known route.

The Thar Desert and Aravalli Hills combine to create a stunning visual backdrop to this journey.

### Day 1: Arrive in Delhi

Stay at: The Lalit, Delhi

On arrival in Delhi we check in to our hotel and have time to freshen up. This afternoon we go on a city tour and see the main sights of New Delhi, which include the President's Palace, Lok Sabha (Parliament), India Gate, the Rajpath and the Lotus temple.

#### Day 2: Delhi- Agra- Bah(Chambal)

Stay at: Chambal Safari Lodge

(Driving Time: Approximately 2hrs by train to Agra and 2 hrs by road to Chambal)

Early-morning post breakfast, transfer to the railway station. Board the Shatabdi Express, one of the fastest trains of India, to Agra. Upon arrival visit the Taj Mahal (closed Fridays) and Agra Fort. Lunch at a local restaurant and later drive to Chambal National Park for two nights.

#### Day 3: Bah(Chambal)

Stay at: Chambal Safari Lodge

This morning enjoy a jungle safari through remote hamlets hidden within the folds of the Chambal and Yamuna ravines. This afternoon you will experience a river safari on the gentle waters of the Chambal River, providing spectacular opportunities to view alligators, turtles and even dolphins. The Chambal Safari boatmen are exceptionally skilled at cutting the boat engines and manoeuvring as dose to the birds and animals as possible without disturbing them. Trained naturalists accompany visitors and provide expert information on the Chambal wildlife.

### Day 4: Bah(Chambal) – Agra – Jhansi – Orchha – Khajuraho

Stay at: Radisson Hotel, Khajuraho

#### (Driving Time: Approx 10 hours)

After an early breakfast we leave for Agra to take the train to Jhansi and then drive to Khajuraho via Orchha. Stop at Orchha for a pure veg meal and also for sightseeing. Visit the Orchha Fort Complex, which was built by Raja Bir Singh Ju Deo in the 17th century and boasts interiors of intricate murals. Later continue to Khajuraho and arrive in the early evening. Check in at the hotel and overnight stay at the hotel.


### Day 5: Khajuraho - Bandhavgarh

Stay at: Bandhav Vilas, Bandhavgarh

#### (Driving Time: Approx 5 hours)

Morning post breakfast visit the beautifully and intricately carved temples of Khajuraho. Built between 950 and 1050 AD these temples depict highly sensual scenes, carved in stone; more so women carvings in her various daily activities from decking up to writing a letter and cooking to sleeping! These temples renowned the world over.

Post Lunch continue onto Bandhavgarh National Park, one of India's finest national parks and home to the country's largest concentration of tigers. Upon arrival check in at the hotel and have dinner. Overnight stay at hotel.





#### Day 6: Bandhavgarh

Stay at: Bandhav Vilas, Bandhavgarh

Search for wildlife in the company of a trained ranger with morning and afternoon game drives today. Along with tigers Bandhavgarh park is home to leopards, chital (spotted deer), sambar deer, nilgai, wild boar, chinkara, sloth bears, jungle cats, rhesus macaques, grey langurs, hyenas, porcupines, jackals, foxes and wild dogs. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.





### Day 7: Bandhavgarh

Stay at: Bandhav Vilas, Bandhavgarh

2 game drives, morning and afternoon in search of the royal beast, the tiger. All meals at the hotel.





### Day 8: Bandhavgarh - Kanha

Stay at: Royal Tiger Resort, Kanha

#### (Driving Time: Approx 6 hours)

Post breakfast in the morning drive to Kanha National Park, arriving mid-afternoon. One of India's largest nature reserves, Kanha boasts vast sal tree forests, flourishing green meadows and lush bamboo growth. This prime tiger-spotting wilderness also supports endangered hard-ground swamp deer (barasingha), sambar deer, chital deer, gaur (Indian bison), striped hyenas, leopards and 200 species of birds.

Upon arrival check in at the hotel and have Lunch. Half day at leisure. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.





### Day 9: Kanha

Stay at: Royal Tiger Resort, Kanha

#### (Driving Time: Approx 6 hours)

2 game drives, morning and afternoon in search of the royal beast, the tiger. All meals at the hotel.







#### General guidelines while Traveling to Indian subcontinent

#### Visa Formalities /Information

- Foreign nationals wishing to travel to India are required to possess a valid passport of their country and a valid Indian visa. However, nationals of Nepal and Bhutan do not require visa to enter India and nationals of Maldives do not require visa for entry in India for a period up to 90 days (a separate visa regime exists for diplomatic/official passport holders).
- The Consular Passport and Visa (CPV) Division of the Ministry of External Affairs is responsible for issuing Indian visas to foreign nationals for their visit for various purposes. This facility is granted through various Indian missions abroad.
- Visa fees are non-refundable and subject to change without notice. The Embassy / High Commission/Consulate reserves the right on granting and deciding the type/duration of visa irrespective of the fees tendered at the time of making the application.
- Visa on arrival facility is limited to the below listed nationalities.
- Only for citizens of Finland , Luxembourg, Singapore, New Zealand, Japan, Cambodia, Laos, Vietnam, Philippines, Indonesia and Myanmar.
