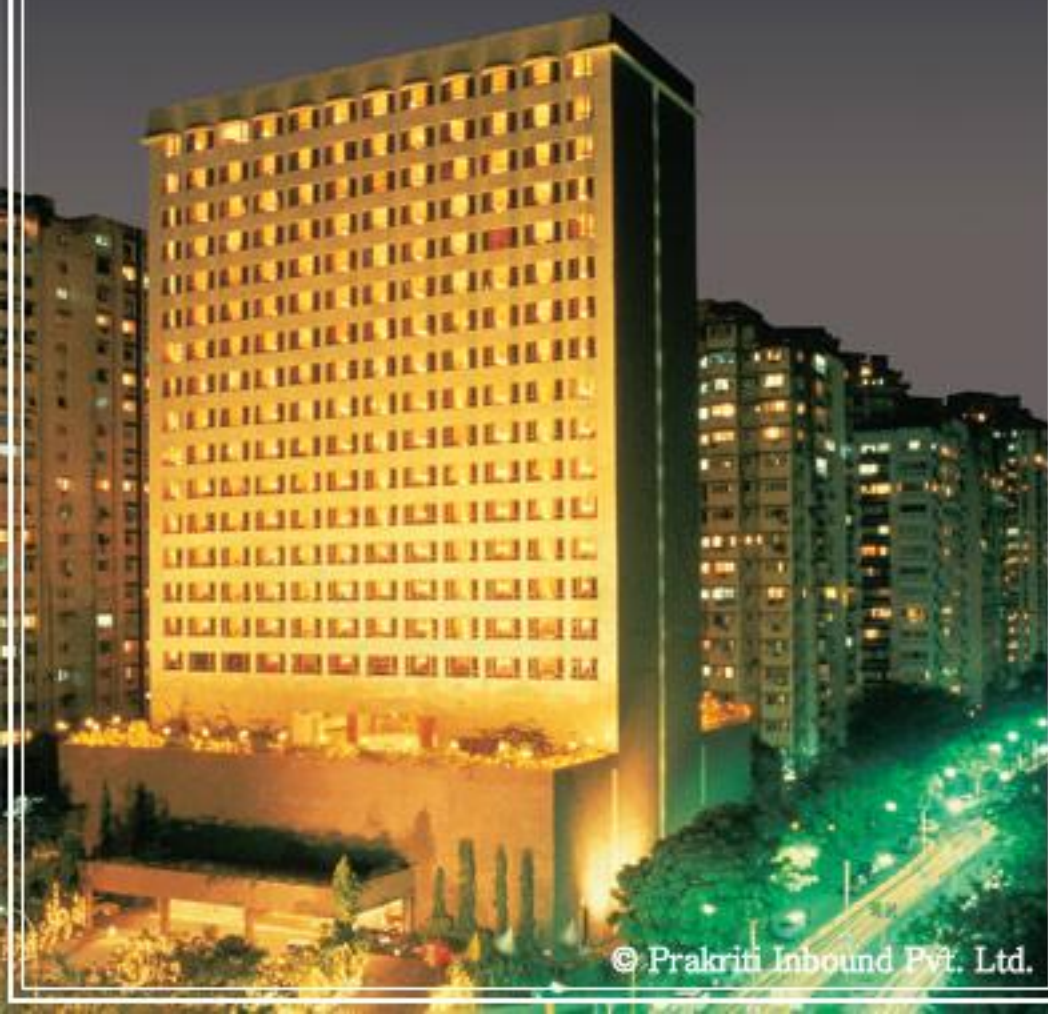

Post an early breakfast at the hotel, transfer to take the morning flight to Nagpur. On the way, drive past the Gateway of India and the Marine drive.

Upon arrival at Nagpur, directly drive to Serai Tiger, Tadoba

Welcome to Tadoba. This is a project Tiger reserve park, the oldest National Parks of Maharashtra. It is a 120-sq-km park, perched at an altitude of 200m. Tadoba is also referred to as The Jewel of Vidarbha. Tadoba is the deity worshipped by the Gond tribe who used to stay here and hence the park is addressed with the same name.

Check in & lunch at hotel, later in the evening Elephant Safari. Dinner & night stay at lodge in Tadoba

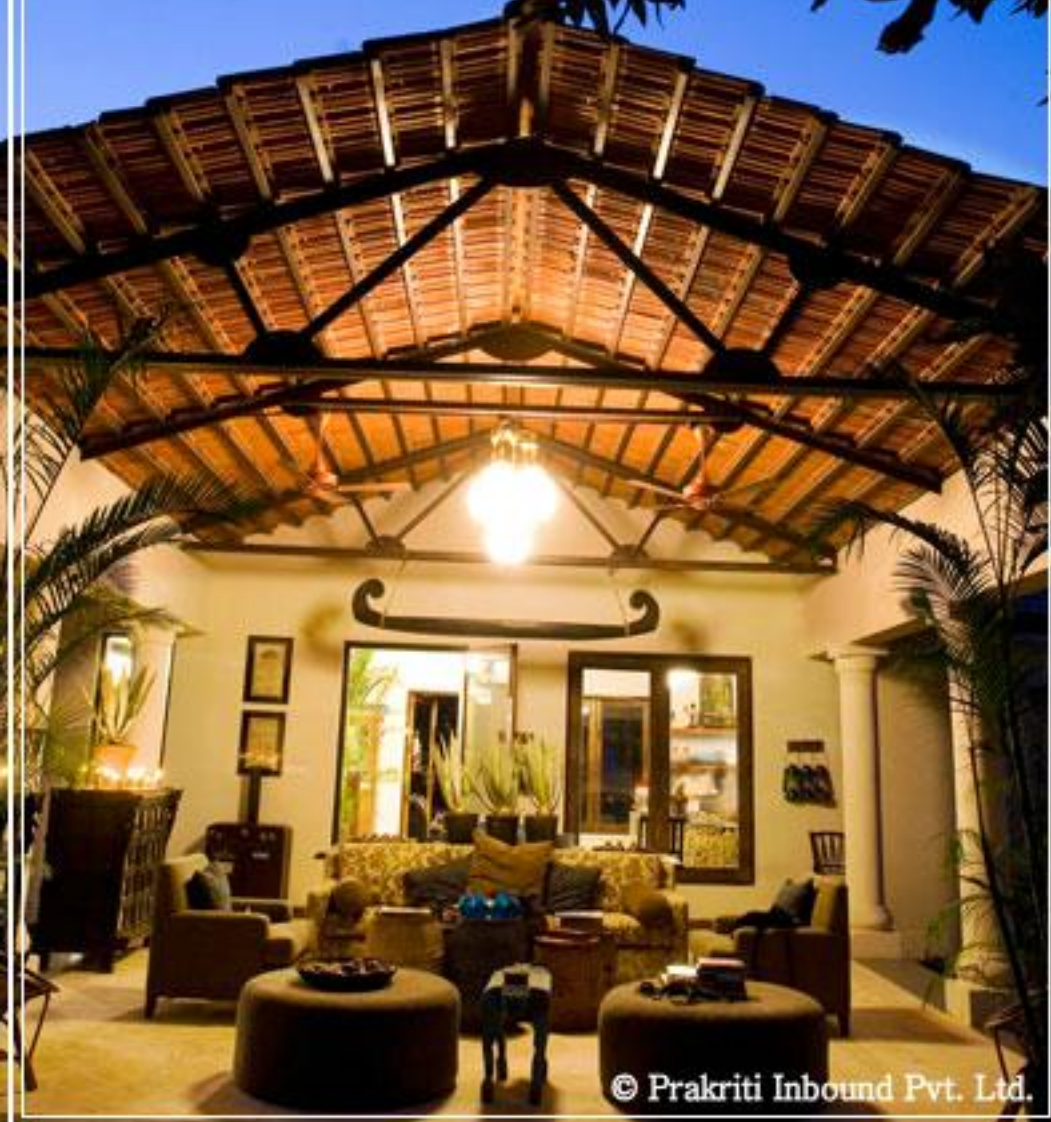
After an early morning breakfast start the day at Tadoba with Jeep Safari. Return to the lodge for lunch. Later in the evening Jungle Safari excursion around 2- 3 hrs by Jeep.

Activities which can be done in this park are: Bird watching: Migratory & water birds, there are more than 200 species of birds and Tiger watching: Tigers and Panthers are the major carnivores in the park.

Day 4: Tadoba National Park – Pench Tiger Reserve

Pench Tiger Reserve and its neighborhoods is the original setting of Rudyard Kipling's most famous work, The Jungle Book.

The area is especially famous for large herds of Gaur (Indian Bison), Cheetha, Sambar, Nilgai, Wild Dog and Wild boar. The key predator is the Tiger followed by Leopard, Wild Dog and Wolf. Other animals include Sloth Bear, Chousingha, Chinkara, Barking Deer, Jackal, Fox, Palm Civet, Small Indian Civet, Jungle Cat, Hyena, Porcupine etc. Check in lodge, Lunch at lodge.

Jeep safari excursion around 2-3hrs & Bird watching.

The Wildlife attractions of Pench includes 39 species of mammals, 13 species of reptiles, 3 species of amphibians and more than 210 varieties of birds. Dinner & stay night at lodge in Pench

Day 5: Pench Tiger Reserve – Kanha National Park

Kanha, the land of Sal and Bamboo forests with tall grass and meandering streams is famous around 165 kms from the city of Jabalpur is located on vast land of nearly 100 sq kms. Kanha is famous for the Tiger reserve. Kanha is rich in Flora and Fauna .

Check in lodge, lunch at lodge.

Jeep Safari excursion around 2- 3hrs. Kanha National Park is also known as Jungle book.

Day 6: Kanha National Park – Bandavgarh National Park

Bandavgarh is another place near Jabalpur famous for the Tiger Reserve forests. With highest density of Tigers in their natural habitats and the first place where the white Tiger was spotted first, Bandavgarh is one of the best Tiger sanctuaries of India. There are many other animals in these forests as well. Like the Deer, Sloth bear, Bison, Nilgai and is home to a variety of pheasants as well.

Check in and have lunch at lodge

Jeep Safari excursion around 2- 3hrs. There are around 25 resident tigers.

Dinner & staynight at lodge in Bandavgarh.

Morning and evening jungle excursion to explore the wildlife, flora and fauna within the national park.

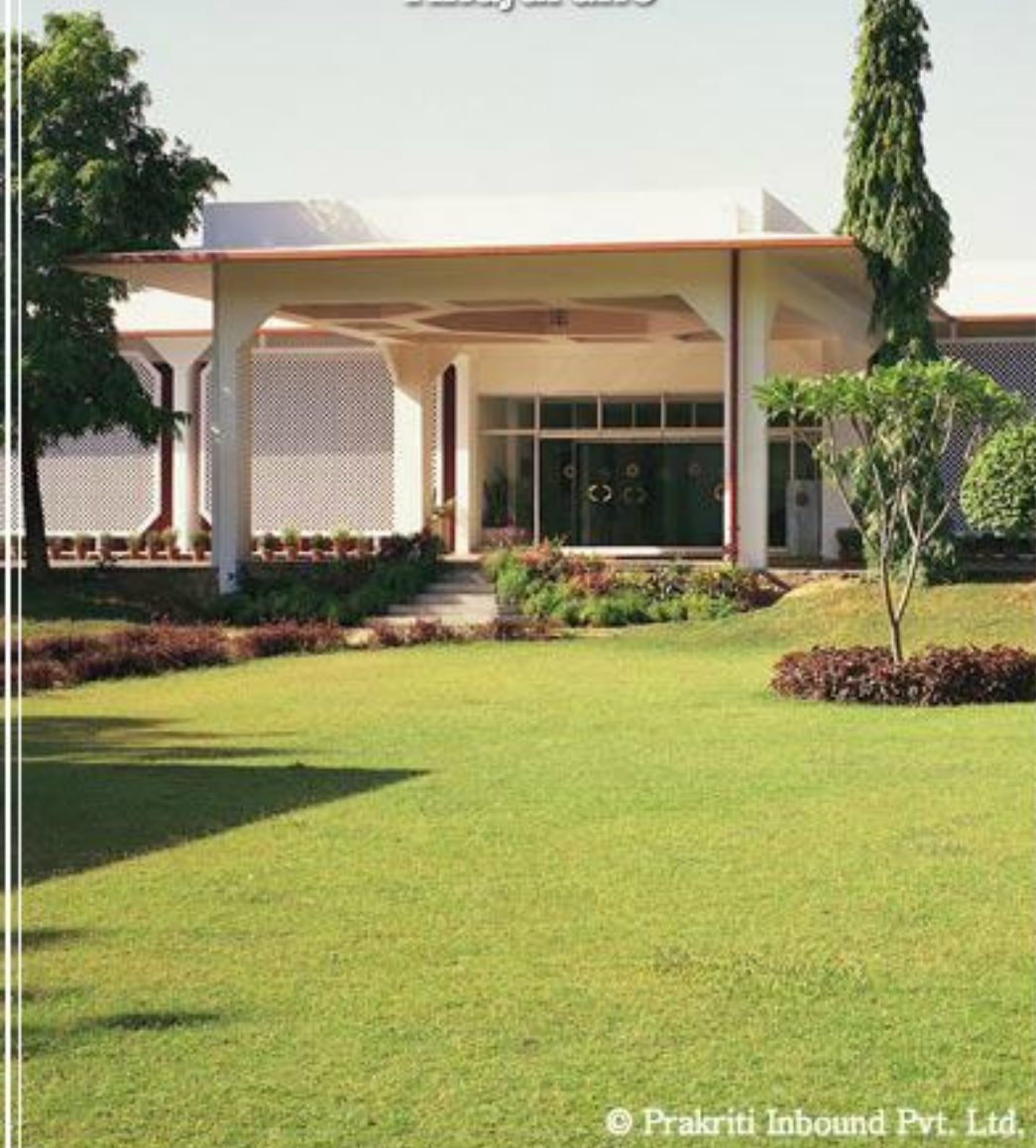
After morning breakfast we proceed for Jeep Safari excursion around 2- 3hrs.

Day 8: Bandavgarh National Park – Khajuraho

Khajuraho is located in the north eastern part of the state, in the region known as Bundelkhand. The exquisite temples are located on the banks of River Betwa, in the forested plains of Madhya Pradesh, around 380 kms away from the capital city of Bhopal.

Lunch at restaurant and after lunch Check in hotel.

Visit to main temples are Kandariya Mahadev temple dedicated to Shiva, Chousat Yogini temple dedicated to kali , The Varaha Temple stands opposite the Matangeshwara temple and is dedicated to the fourth incarnation of Lord Vishnu in form of a Boar. Few other temples are Laxman Temple, Vishwanath temple and Chitragupta temple.

Day 9: Khajuraho – Jhansi (via Orchha) – Agra

Stay at:- [The Gateway Hotel, Agra](#)

Sightseeing of Southern group of temples which are less known as they are few kms away from the main village of Khajuraho.

Drive from Khajuraho to Jhansi via Orchha Fort (around 185 Km journey)

The Fort of Orchha is what Orchha is all about. The most important monument inside the fort is the Jehangir Mahal, built to commemorate the visit of Emperor Jehangir to Orchha. The Raj Mahal gives a clear picture, of the royalty with which the kings lived.

Lunch at restaurant in Orchha & sightseeing of the Fort of Orchha, transfer to Jhansi railway station (around 20 Km) Board train to Agra for onward journey . Upon arrival transfer from Railway station to Hotel in Agra.

Dinner & overnight stay at hotel in Agra.

Day 10: Agra – Fatehpur Sikri – Jaipur

After the breakfast at the hotel , transfer to visit the most covered Monument, the Taj. The beauty of the Taj is in its simplicity. The Taj although made of white marble can give an impression of hues of colours pertaining to the sun rays at the time of the day. After the blisfull experience visit the magnificent fort of Agra, also known as the Red fort. Later proceed for Fatehpur Sikri: A royal city perfectly preserved, Fatehpur Sikri provides a marvelous escape into the past.

Dinner & night stay at hotel in Jaipur.

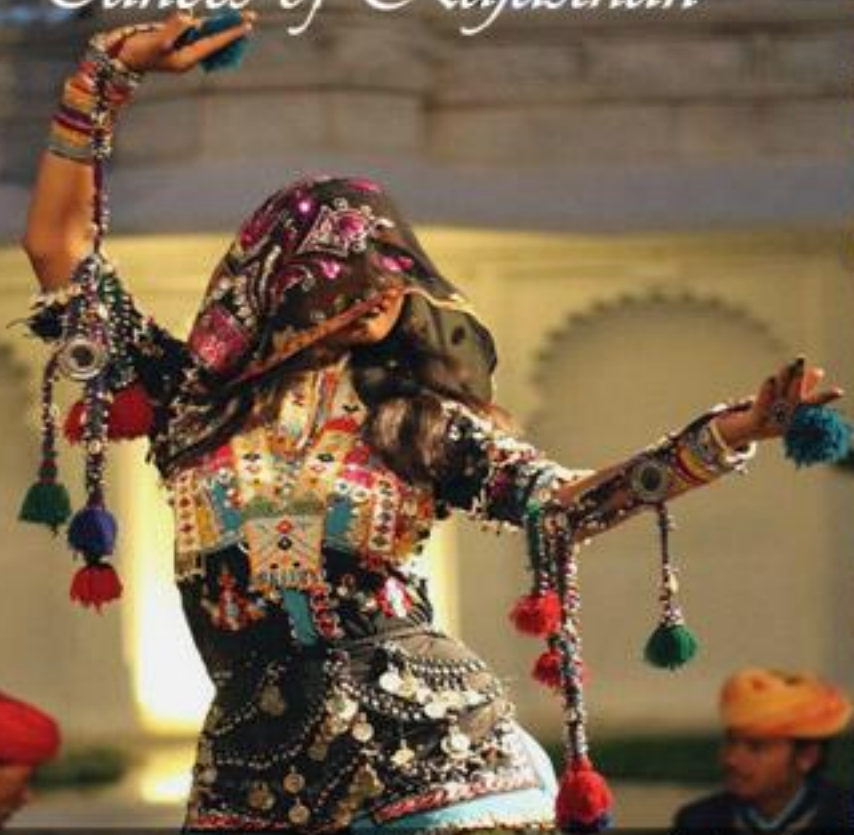

General guidelines while Traveling to Indian subcontinent

Visa Formalities /Information

- Foreign nationals wishing to travel to India are required to possess a valid passport of their country and a valid Indian visa. However, nationals of Nepal and Bhutan do not require visa to enter India and nationals of Maldives do not require visa for entry in India for a period up to 90 days (a separate visa regime exists for diplomatic/official passport holders).
- The Consular Passport and Visa (CPV) Division of the Ministry of External Affairs is responsible for issuing Indian visas to foreign nationals for their visit for various purposes. This facility is granted through various Indian missions abroad.
- Visa fees are non-refundable and subject to change without notice. The Embassy / High Commission/Consulate reserves the right on granting and deciding the type/duration of visa irrespective of the fees tendered at the time of making the application.
- Visa on arrival facility is limited to the below listed nationalities.
-Only for citizens of Finland , Luxembourg, Singapore, New Zealand, Japan, Cambodia, Laos, Vietnam, Philippines, Indonesia and Myanmar.

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
