The central glass pavillion or the 'jewel box' houses the lobby on the fifth floor, with spectacular views of the water body.

## Day 2: Delhi

After breakfast you'll depart on a half day combined sightseeing tour of Old and New Delhi. The tour starts with the historic Old Delhi and makes its way to exciting New Delhi. Old Delhi: Visit Jama Masjid the mosque of Friday that can accommodate 20,000 at one time, Visit Raj Ghat where Mahatma Gandhi, The Father of Nation, was cremated. Drive past Red Fort the Palace for Shahjahan's new capital, Shahjahanabad, the seventh Muslim city in the Delhi site and mile long Chandni Chowk New Delhi: Visit Qutab Minar the 239 ft. sand stone tower, an Indo-Islamic architectural wonder of ancient India. Visit Humayun's Tomb base model of Taj Mahal. Drive past India Gate War Memorial Arch, Parliament House and President's Palace. After the tour, return to your Hotel where the balance of the day at leisure. Overnight at Hotel.

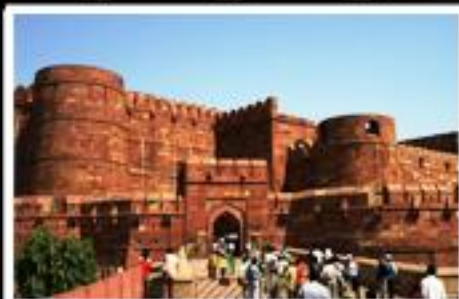

## Day 3: Delhi – Agra

Stay at:- [The Oberoi Amarvilas, Agra](#)

Today you will be transferred to Agra, the second capital of the Mughal Empire. On arrival you have the chance to freshen up before visiting the iconic Taj Mahal. The Taj Mahal was created by Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan for his favorite wife Mumtaz Mahal. It took 22 years to be completed and was designed and planned by Persian architect Ustad Isa. Noted for its stunning design balance and perfect symmetry, elegant domes, intricately carved screens and some of the best inlay work ever seen. After visiting the Taj Mahal, you'll have a guided tour of the Agra Fort. The Agra Fort is an imposing structure with walls of red sandstone and is almost two miles long. It contains palaces, audience halls and mosques built by all three emperors. Overnight at Hotel.

## Day 4: Agra – Fatehpur Sikri – Jaipur

After breakfast you'll begin your journey to Jaipur. En-route, stop for a visit in the city of Fatehpur Sikri which was built by the Mughal Emperor Akbar in gratitude of Muslim saint Sheikh Salim Chishti during 1564 AD. The architectural fusion depicted in the buildings here has made it one of the most revered tourist attractions. After the visit continue to Jaipur. Overnight at Hotel.

## Day 5: Jaipur

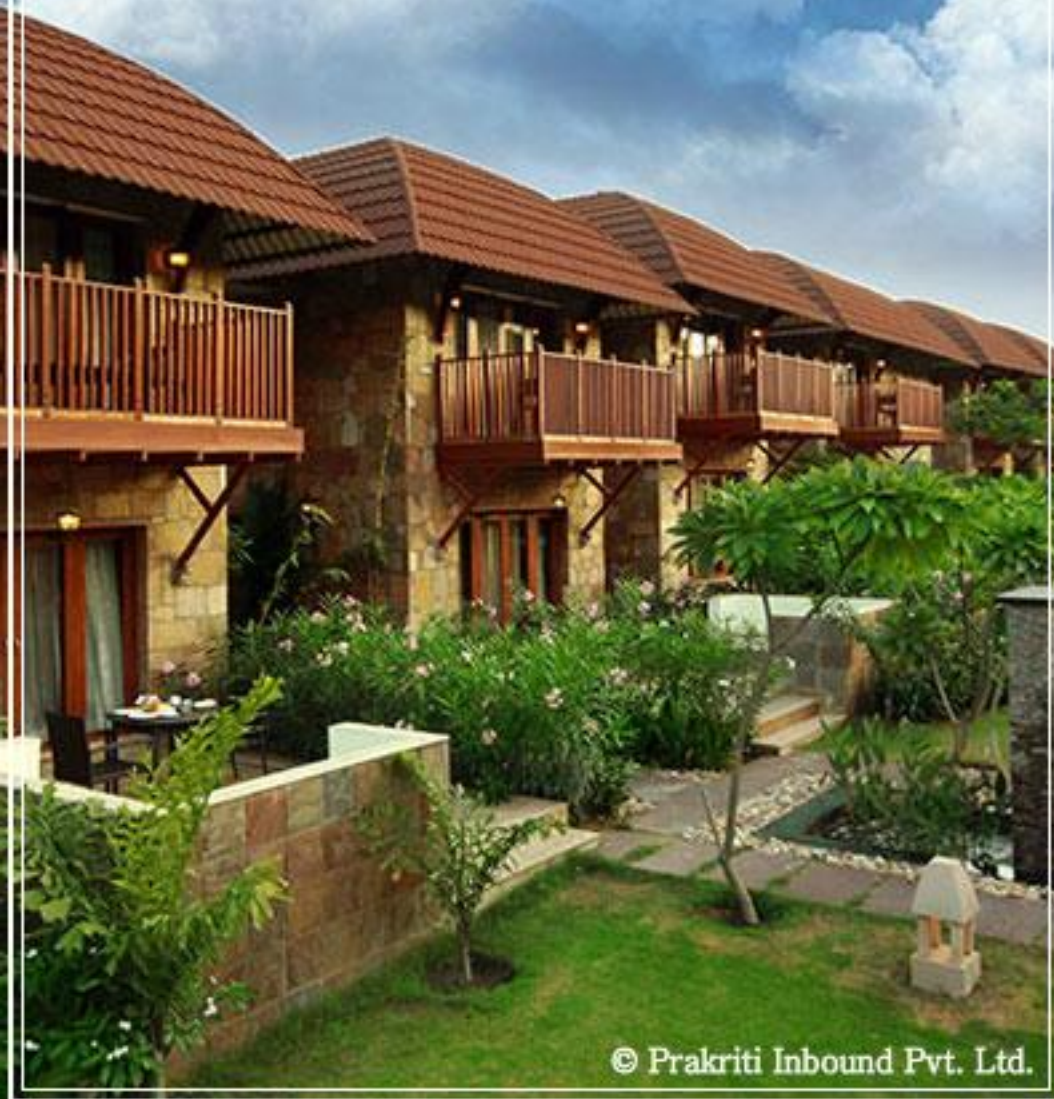
Stay at:- [The Oberoi Rajvilas, Jaipur](#)

After breakfast you will be transferred to Amber Fort. Photo stop at the Hawa Mahal or the Palace of Wind. Amber Fort is the classic romantic Rajasthan fort-palace, built for a defense but is a virtual paradise inside. Elephant ride up to the fort are an unforgettable experience but are on a first come, first served basis and cannot be reserved, only a limited number of elephants are allowed to make the trek each day (Alternatively, should the elephant ride not be available jeep rides to the fort are available) This afternoon your city tour begins with a visit to the Maharaja's City Palace. The sprawling complex served as home to Jaipur rulers since the early 18th century. Now it's part museum with sections exhibiting some of the family memorabilia and is collection of the royal Jaipur family. A section of the palace is currently residence for the present day Maharaja Bhavani Singh. Next visit an astronomical observatory, Jantar Mantar the largest stone and marble crafted observatory in the world. After the city tour, return to hotel. Overnight at Hotel.

## Day 6: Jaipur – Pushkar

Stay at:- [Ananta Spa & Resorts, Pushkar](#)

After breakfast you'll depart to Pushkar, one of the oldest cities of India which lies on the Shore of Pushkar Lake. Pushkar is also one of the five sacred dhams (pilgrimage sites for devout Hindus). Upon arrival, you'll check in at hotel. This afternoon, you will be taken on a walking tour of the holy city of the god, Brahma. Visit the Holy Lake and Visit the famous Brahma Temple. See a special Pooja ceremony at a Ghats. Overnight at Hotel.

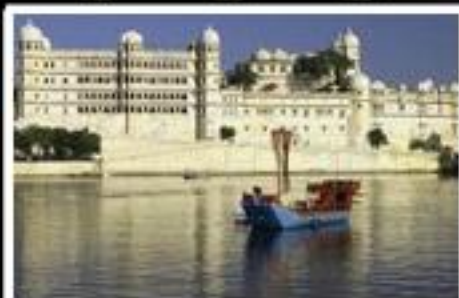

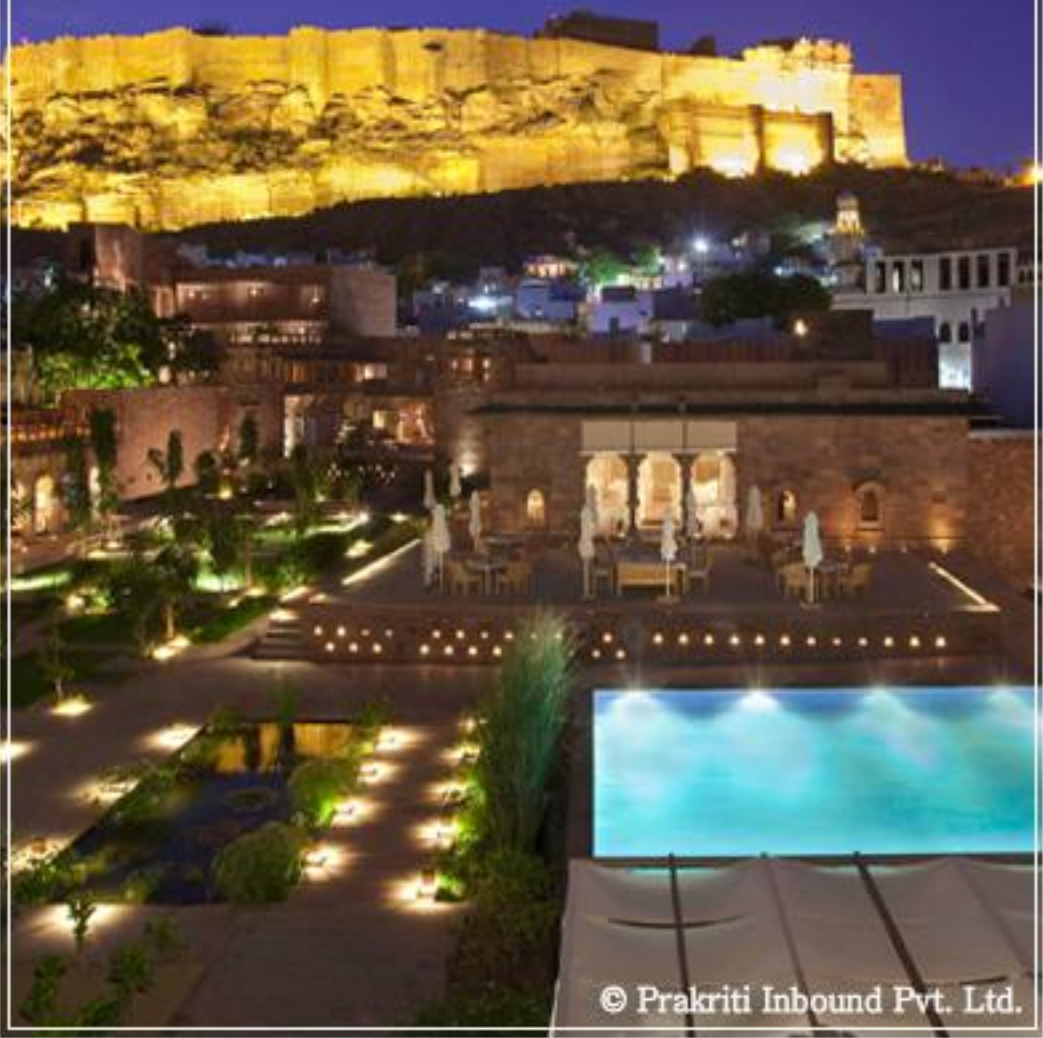
## Day 8: Udaipur

Stay at:- [The Oberoi Udaivilas, Udaipur](#)

Start your morning off with a half-day sightseeing tour of Udaipur. Begin with the City Palace, built in 1725 a conglomerate of eleven palaces overlooking the sprawling Lake Pichola. Continue to Jagdish Temple, built in 1651 by Maharaja Jagat Singh dedicated to Lord Vishnu and located in the center of the city. Also visit Sahelion-ki-badi. After the tour, return to your hotel where the rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight stay Hotel.

## Day 10: Jodhpur – Jaisalmer

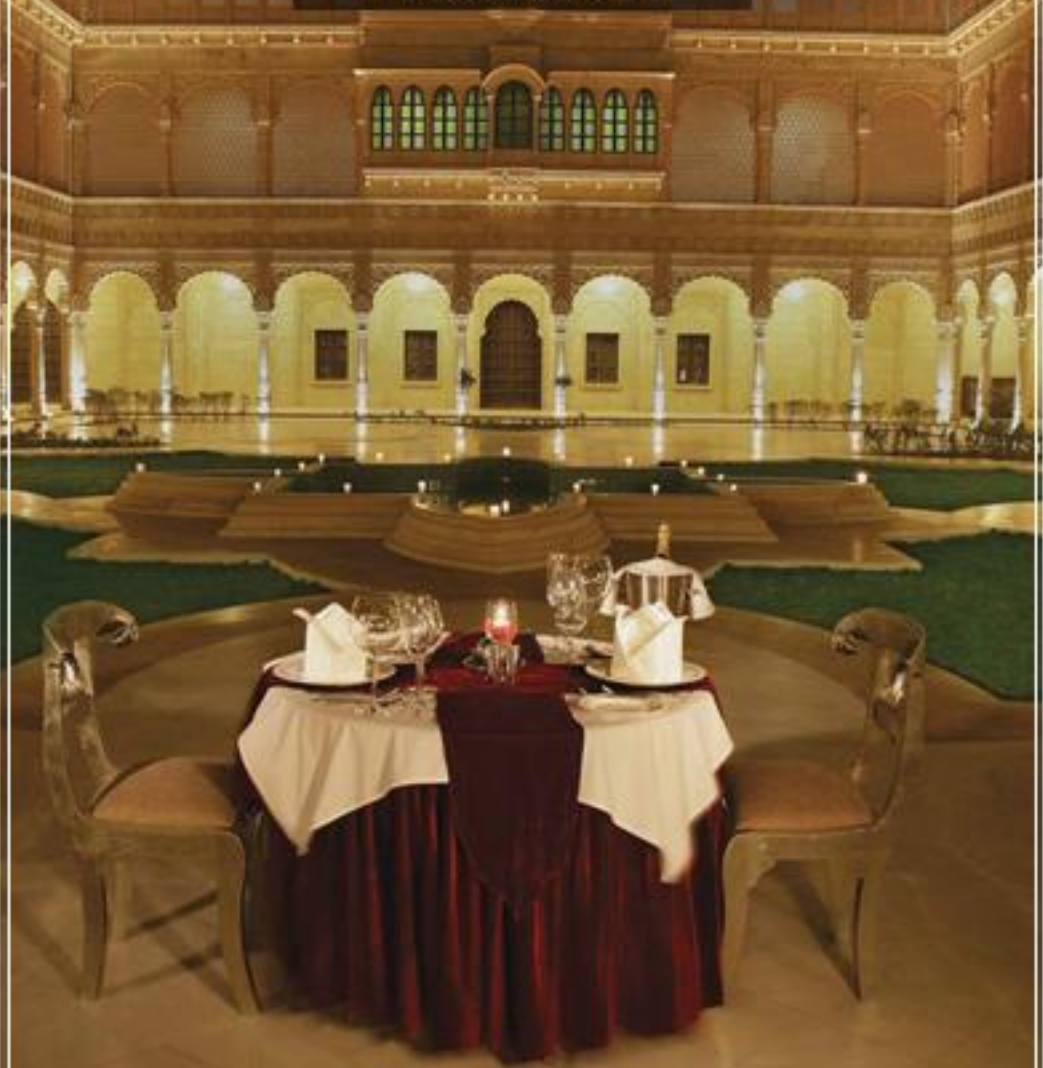
Stay at:- [Suryagarh, Jaisalmer](#)

After breakfast you will be taken for a half-day sightseeing tour of Jodhpur. Visit the Mehrangarh Fort, situated on a low sandstone hill. Also see the Jaswant Thada; an imposing marble memorial to Maharaja Jaswant Singh II built in 1899 Visit the royal crematorium and three other cenotaphs. Visit the Museum located in the Umaid Bhawan Palace. After the tour, you'll depart to the desert town of Jaisalmer. Overnight at Hotel.

## Day 11: Jaisalmer

Stay at:- [Suryagarh, Jaisalmer](#)

After a leisurely breakfast, you will be taken for a half-day sight seeing tour of Jaisalmer. Begin with a visit to Jaisalmer Fort built on the triangular shaped Trikuta hill; it's enclosed by a 9m wall with 99 bastions. Visit the merchant havelis like Patwon-ki-haveli and Nathmal-ji-kihaveli in the evening you will have a camel ride at Sam Sand Dunes with dinner. Sam Sand Dunes is the most popular excursions to see the total sandy bush less desert Best to be seen at sunrise or sunset. After dinner return to your hotel. Overnight at Hotel.

After breakfast depart to Bikaner and see where the late Maharaja Ganga Singh single-handedly transformed his backward feudal domain into Rajasthan greenery by building the Ganga Canal. Upon arrival, check in at Laxmi Niwas Palace (Heritage). After you've freshened up you'll visit a camel breeding farm. The balance of the day at leisure. Overnight at Hotel.



# Hotel Castle Mandawa



## Day 13: Bikaner - Mandawa

Stay at:- [Castle Mandawa, Mandawa](#)

After breakfast, visit Junagarh Fort. Begun by Raja Rai Singh in the 16th century, but was added on to over the next three centuries. The outer wall is surrounded by a moat and the interior has beautifully designed palaces. After the visit you will depart to Mandawa where you will have time to freshen up at the hotel before a walking tour of Mandawa dominated by a painted arched gateway adorned with Lord Krishna and his cows. You'll also visit Chokhani and Ladia Havelis and the street with Saraf Havelis. Overnight at Hotel.





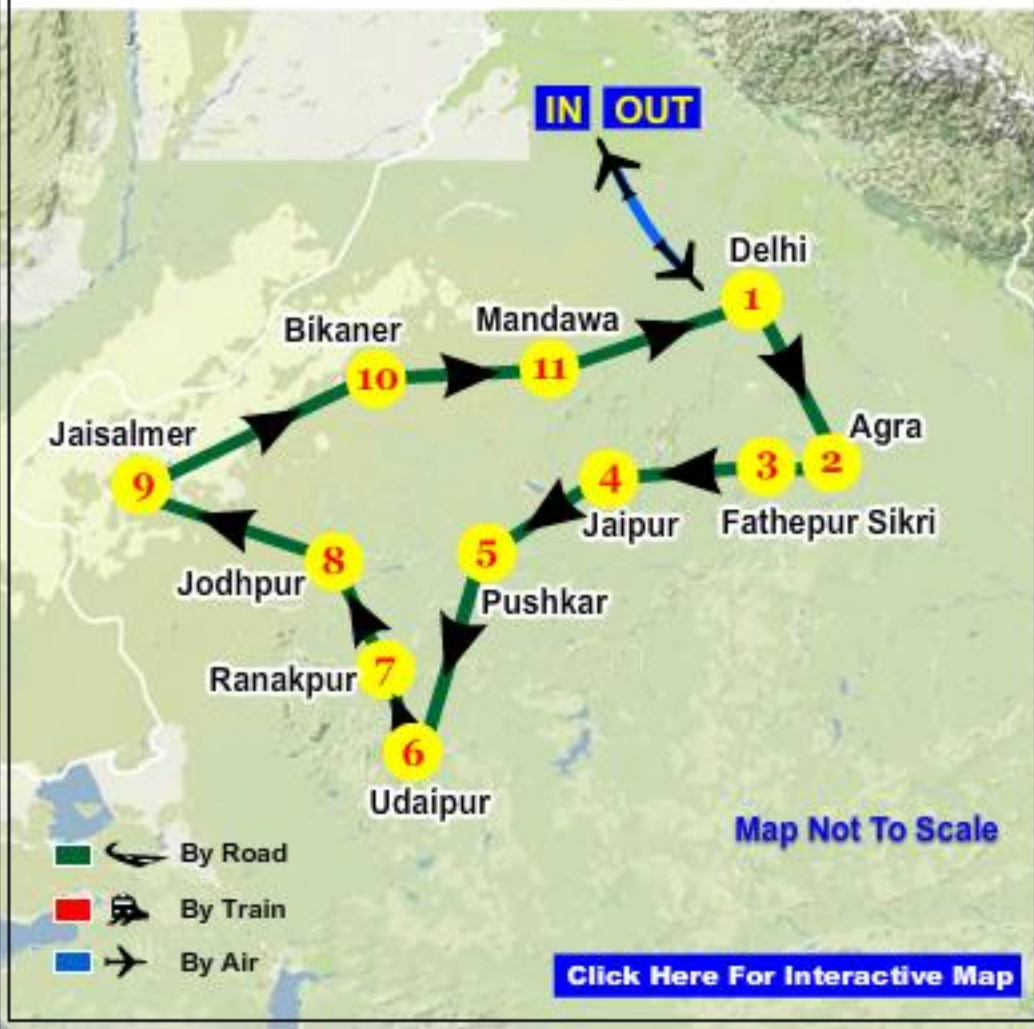
# Delhi International Airport



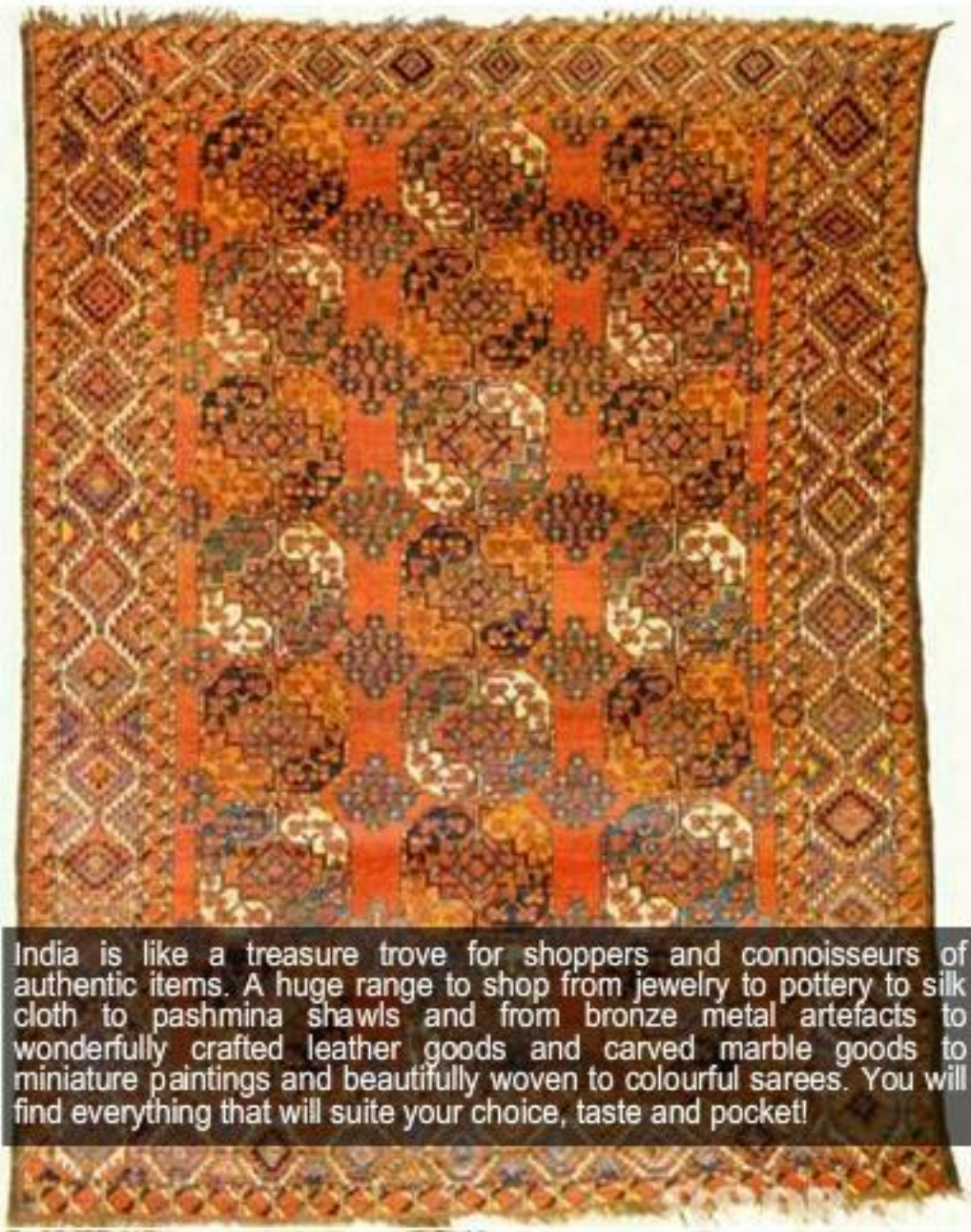

After breakfast, drive to New Delhi Airport (DEL) for your onward flight.





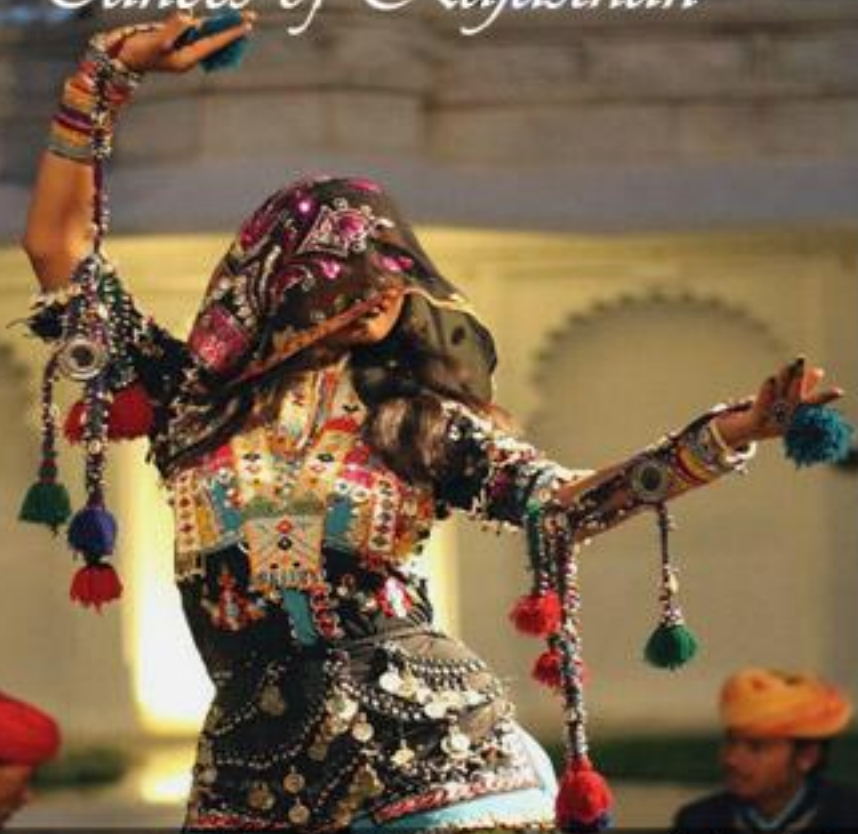

## **General guidelines while Traveling to Indian subcontinent**

### **Visa Formalities /Information**

- Foreign nationals wishing to travel to India are required to possess a valid passport of their country and a valid Indian visa. However, nationals of Nepal and Bhutan do not require visa to enter India and nationals of Maldives do not require visa for entry in India for a period up to 90 days (a separate visa regime exists for diplomatic/official passport holders).
- The Consular Passport and Visa (CPV) Division of the Ministry of External Affairs is responsible for issuing Indian visas to foreign nationals for their visit for various purposes. This facility is granted through various Indian missions abroad.
- Visa fees are non-refundable and subject to change without notice. The Embassy / High Commission/Consulate reserves the right on granting and deciding the type/duration of visa irrespective of the fees tendered at the time of making the application.
- Visa on arrival facility is limited to the below listed nationalities.  
-Only for citizens of Finland , Luxembourg, Singapore, New Zealand, Japan, Cambodia, Laos, Vietnam, Philippines, Indonesia and Myanmar.
