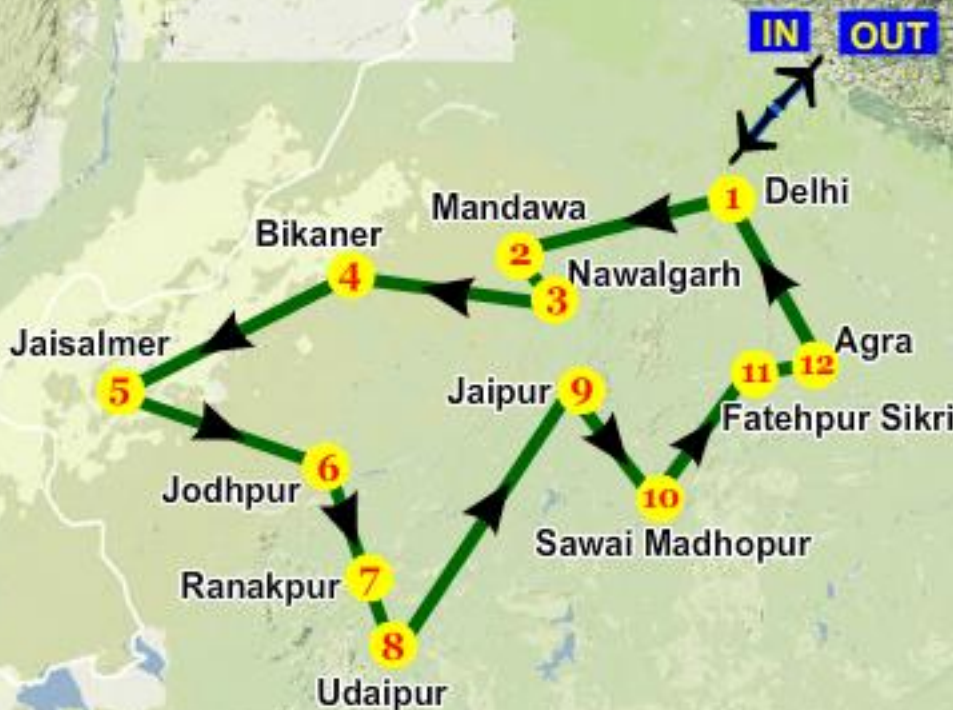

Day 3: Mandawa - Nawalgarh - Bikaner

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to Bikaner via Nawalgarh. Founded in 1737 and secured by thick stone walls and a fortress, the place offered the enterprising merchants stability and security, as a result of which many families settled there. Home to more than one hundred havelis, Nawalgarh is also the home of the rich and powerful Poddar merchant family who later became the business tycoons in Mumbai. Their extremely beautiful painted haveli was built in 1920 and is a famous landmark of the city. Arrival in Bikaner is followed by check in at the hotel. Bikaner was once a major stop along the caravan route between the East and West Asia. It is surrounded by a 7 km long city wall including five large doors and negotiates with the historic buildings of the Old Town. Today, the image that comes forth is that of a medieval desert

Camel ride at sunset in the Thar desert The fairytale-like "Golden City" in the Thar Desert is one of the most beautiful desert cities in the world in 1156 AD. Jaisalmer was become an important trading center. The masterfully decorated with intricate stone carvings temples and mansions of wealthy merchants are still preserved in their original beauty and will astound you. Camel ride in the picturesque beautiful sunset in the sand dunes , the " magic of the desert " take finally caught - an unforgettable experience !

Day 6: Jaisalmer – Jodhpur

Later city tour of Jodhpur where you visit the mighty Mehrangarh Fort, the palace complex sits majestically on a 125 m high cliff above the town. Within the fort, which still belongs to the Maharaja of Jodhpur, there are a number of spacious courtyards and palaces with latticed windows and balconies that are made of red sandstone carved with fine details. In the former premises of the Maharajas, etc. today is to see an interesting collection of weapons, miniature paintings, musical instruments, costumes.

Day 7: Jodhpur – Ranakpur – Udaipur

After breakfast, check out from hotel and transfer to Udaipur via Ranakpur. En route, visit the Jain temple of Ranakpur temple complex which is a huge highlight of Jain architecture. The main temple has over 29 geometrically arranged halls covering the vast area of 3,716 m², supported by 1,444 pillars. In addition, the unique lighting gives the interior an aura, which enamors everyvisitor. On arrival in Udaipur, check in at hotel. Overnight stay at hotel.

Afternoon you can enjoy the splendor and romance of this city during the boat ride on Lake Pichola artificial. The island in the south is home to the 17th Century built Jag Mandir Palace, built in the northern island in 1757 Jag Niwas Palace.

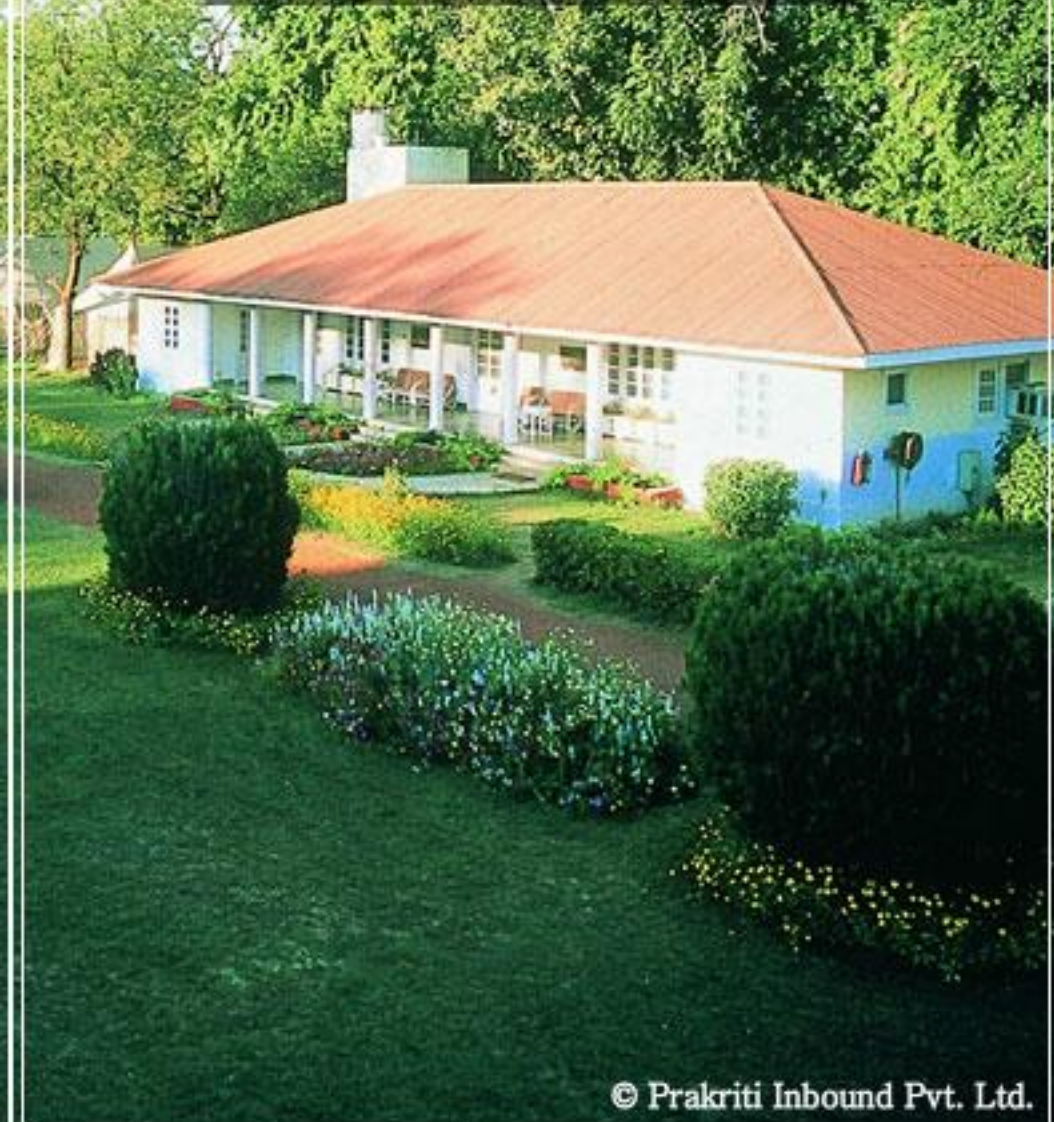

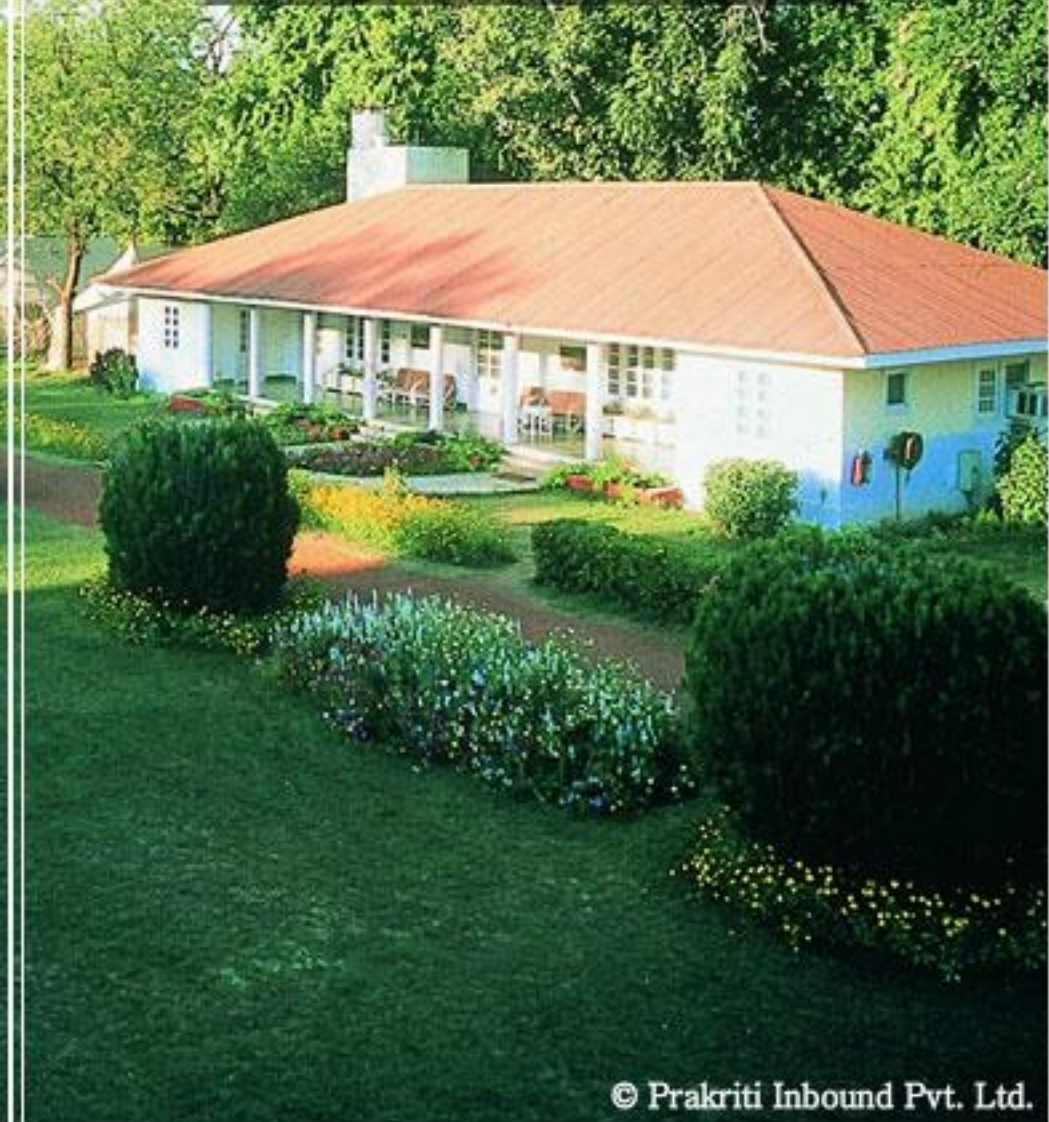
After breakfast, check out from hotel and transfer to Swai Madhopur (Ranthambore National Park).

Multistory palaces, gardens and a marketplace, a waterworks , numerous covered walkways, stairs and terraces are testimony to the architectural masterpiece of Akbar the sunken city combines two opposites.. Figurative and geometric architecture of the Hindus.


Day 14: Agra - Delhi Departure

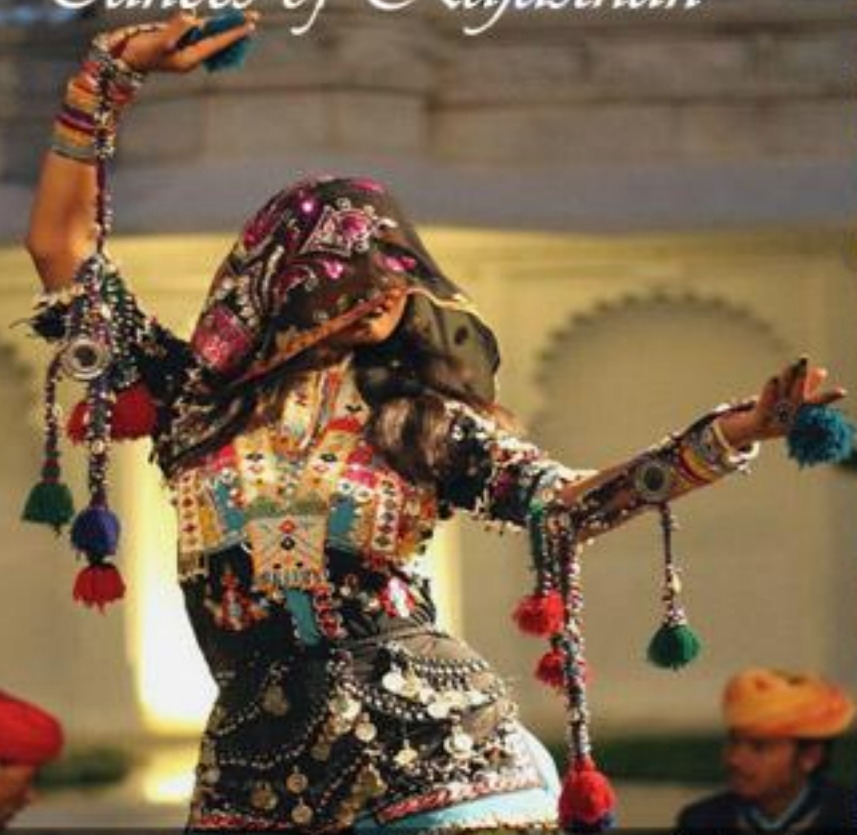

General guidelines while Traveling to Indian subcontinent

Visa Formalities /Information

- Foreign nationals wishing to travel to India are required to possess a valid passport of their country and a valid Indian visa. However, nationals of Nepal and Bhutan do not require visa to enter India and nationals of Maldives do not require visa for entry in India for a period up to 90 days (a separate visa regime exists for diplomatic/official passport holders).
- The Consular Passport and Visa (CPV) Division of the Ministry of External Affairs is responsible for issuing Indian visas to foreign nationals for their visit for various purposes. This facility is granted through various Indian missions abroad.
- Visa fees are non-refundable and subject to change without notice. The Embassy / High Commission/Consulate reserves the right on granting and deciding the type/duration of visa irrespective of the fees tendered at the time of making the application.
- Visa on arrival facility is limited to the below listed nationalities.
-Only for citizens of Finland , Luxembourg, Singapore, New Zealand, Japan, Cambodia, Laos, Vietnam, Philippines, Indonesia and Myanmar.
