
The Oberoi, Gurgaon


There are very few places where this rare and enigmatic big cat can still be glimpsed in the wild, stalking through dense forest and undergrowth, a solitary predator with no natural enemies, save one. India has 25 tiger reserves, located in national parks across the country and the highest density of tigers in the world. The elusive Royal Bengal Tiger is the national animal of India, although sadly now an endangered species, with around 1400 still in the wild. Your chances of spotting tiger are dependent upon the time of year, the size of the park and its tiger population. Bandhavgarh, Ranthambhore and Kanha National Park are prime tiger conservation areas and offer the best opportunities for a sighting.


Day 2: Delhi - Jabalpur - Kanha








Day 5: Kanha - Bandhavgarh

The thick forest of Bandhavgarh National Park sits in a bowl encircled by cliffs and wooded Vindhyan Mountains, and its plains have a number of grass and reed covered wetlands where Kingfishers dive and Egrets sit poised, hunch-backed, in the shallows. Up above, vultures nestle in holes in the sheer cliffs. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Bandhavgarh.























Day 1: Bandhavgarh - Khajuraho

Drive to Khajuraho. On arrival check in at hotel. Evening sound and light show at Khajuraho Temples. (Dinner)






Day 2: Khajuraho - Orchha - Jhansi - Agra

Stay at: - The Oberoi Amarvilas, Agra

Morning city sightseeing tour of Khajuraho. The fascinating temples of Khajuraho, India's unique gift of love to the world, in the state of Madhya Pradesh, were built between 950 and 1050 A.D. The divine sculptures in these temples are a tribute to Life itself, embodying everything that is sublime and spontaneous about it. The murals depict the life and times of the Chandelas, and celebrate the erotic state of being. They not only testify to the mastery of the craftsman, but also to the extraordinary breadth of vision of the Chandela Raiput's under whose reign, these temples were constructed. The temples are grouped into three geographical divisions: western, eastern and southern. After breakfast explore the temples of Khajuraho while your guide explains the intricate meaning and legends behind each describable sculpture. Visit Eastern and Western Group of Temples. Later drive to Jhansi Railway station for train to Agra en route visiting Orchha. Post Orchha visit transfer to Jhansi Railway station for train to Agra. Meeting assistance on arrival at Agra Railway station and transfer to hotel. Overnight at hotel.






Day 3: Agra

Morning at sunrise visit the world famous Taj Mahal, built by the Mughal Emperor Shahjehan in 1630 for his queen Mumtaz Mahal to enshrine her mortal remains, Also visit the Agra Fort, containing the Pearl Mosque - the rusty and majestic red- sandstone fort of Agra stands on the banks of the river Yamuna and the construction was started by Emperor Akbar in 1566. At the Diwan-I-Khas (hall of private audience) where marble pavilions with floral inlays lend an ethereal ambience, the Emperor sat on his gem-studded peacock Throne and met foreign ambassadors and rulers of friendly kingdoms. Also visit Itmad-up-Dau's tomb, built by Noorjehan in memory of her father. Overnight at hotel.





Visa Formalities /Information

- Foreign nationals wishing to travel to India are required to possess a valid passport of their country and a valid Indian visa. However, nationals of Nepal and Bhutan do not require visa to enter India and nationals of Maldives do not require visa for entry in India for a period up to 90 days (a separate visa regime exists for diplomatic/official passport holders).
- The Consular Passport and Visa (CPV) Division of the Ministry of External Affairs is responsible for issuing Indian visas to foreign nationals for their visit for various purposes. This facility is granted through various Indian missions abroad.
- Visa fees are non-refundable and subject to change without notice. The Embassy / High Commission/Consulate reserves the right on granting and deciding the type/duration of visa irrespective of the fees tendered at the time of making the application.
- Visa on arrival facility is limited to the below listed nationalities.
- Only for citizens of Finland , Luxembourg, Singapore, New Zealand, Japan, Cambodia, Laos, Vietnam, Philippines, Indonesia and Myanmar.
